More Attention to Scripture Teaching

Contemporary Christianity has witnessed and suffered humiliating and telling blows from persons and sects claiming to be part of redemption heritage.

False teachers garbed in sheep's clothing have entered the religious scene and deceived many. Hoards of susceptible, gullible people have imbibed their heresy, never suspecting that they were being led down a path of unscriptural thinking. Although some of the deceivers have recently been seen as they really are, their untaught followers continue to stumble after them, having no perception of Scripture teachings.

Even in evangelical and fundamental circles well-meaning people live lives that demonstrate a tragic paucity of understanding regarding Biblical themes, standards, authority, and ethics.

To what might these problems be attributed?

Without doubt some of the fault lies with weak approaches to Scripture. The vogue in many Christian communities has been a shallow topical preaching designed to entertain with jokes and tear- jerking stories that illustrate man's ideas but are devoid of Biblical significance. One needs only a strong feeling for or against something and a 'gift of gab' and he can quickly set forth arguments to buttress his notions as well as verses of Scripture to stretch and twist until they appear to support those notions.

Scripture texts become pegs on which ministers hand whatever ideas they wish and forced it down on the innocents. The lamentable result is a lack of understanding among laymen and clergymen regarding the coherent unity of Scripture. The Word of God is viewed as a collection of unconnected truisms. People are taught to approach the Scripture with the question "What can I say about this text?" rather than "What does this text say?"

Proper understanding of Scripture will be in part, the product of a proper attitude toward its content. One needs to approach the Word of God with a realisation that it is a unified revelation. It was canonised over many centuries by many writers who were inspired by Holy Spirit. It bears an unmistakable unity of thrust from beginning to end. It is a thematic revelation.

Its unity is evident as certain themes begin in seed form in Genesis, develop and grow in the historical and prophetic books of Old Testament, then reach full maturity in the New

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Testament. The Bible is also an anticipatory book. There is a constant forward look. The Old Testament saints and writers looked ahead to the Messiah. The New Testament writers look ahead to the second coming of the Messiah and to eternity. It is a self- fulfilling revelation as well. Hence one verse cannot be isolated from the whole.

The teaching of the Bible in this Ministry will be accurately discerned as it is understood in relation to surrounding verses and the Scripture as a whole. As one perceives the whole more fully, one will discern more precisely the meaning of a single verse. With this understanding grace one's study is done to guard from the tortuous abuse of Scripture that has become so accepted and popular. One then realise that Scripture is not a collection of disjointed truisms, but is indeed a unified, thematic, anticipatory and self – fulfilling revelation. Once this is established the student of God's Word is equipped to delve deeper into its endless store of treasure and is shown a ruthless path that avoids pitfalls and is free of detours from the message of God

A valuable reference work is given to our students for locating specific historical records in teaching of the Scripture.

If the truths as will be taught in this Ministry keep even on one

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minister or a Christian leader from fallen prey to Satanic pitfall and human character flaws then it will be worth all I have gone through to pioneer this Ministry in Christian Theological Seminary/Bible college education.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

THE BIBLE

We believe the Bible, comprised of the Old and New Testaments, to be the inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God (Matthew 5:18; 2 Timothy 3:16-17).

GOD

We have sound believe in one God, Creator of all (Deuteronomy 6:4; Colossians 1:16), who has revealed Himself in three distinct Persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (2 Corinthians 13:14), yet who is one in being, glory and essence (John 10:30).

JESUS CHRIST

We have sound believe in the deity of the Lord Jesus Christ. He is God in human form, He is God incarnate, the expressed image of the Father, who, without ceasing to be God, became man in order that He might demonstrate who God is and provide the means of salvation for humanity (Matthew 1:21; John 1:18; Colossians 1:15). Conceived of the Holy Spirit and was born of the virgin Mary. Lived a perfect, sinless life, died on the cross for all humanity and rose on the third day. (1 John 2: Matthew 1:23). We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross for all humanity (1 John 2:2) as a subtitutionary sacrifice (Isaiah 53:5-6). We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ ascended to Heaven in His glorified body (Acts 1:9-10) and is now seated at the right hand of God as our High Priest and Advocate (Romans 8:34; Hebrews 7:25).

THE HOLY SPIRIT

We believe in the deity and personality of the Holy Spirit (Acts 5:3-4). He regenerates sinners (Titus 3:5) and indwells believers (Romans 8:9). He is the agent by whom Christ baptizes all believers into His body (1 Corinthians 12:12-14). He is the seal by whom the Father guarantees the salvation of believers unto the day of redemption (Ephesians 1:13-14). He is the Divine Teacher who illumines believers' hearts and minds as they study the Word of God (1 Corinthians 2:9-12).

ANGELS AND DEMONS

We believe in the reality and personality of angels. We believe that God created the angels to be His servants and messengers (Nehemiah 9:6; Psalm 148:2; Hebrews 1:14).

We believe in the existence and personality of Satan and demons. Satan is a fallen angel who led a group of angels in rebellion against God (Isaiah 14:12-17; Ezekiel 28:12-15). He is the great enemy of God and man, and the demons are his servants in evil. He and his demons will be eternally punished in the lake of fire (Matthew 25:41; Revelation 20:10).

HUMANITY

We in URCCM strongly believe that man, humanity in general came into existence by direct creation of God, uniquely made in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:26-27). All humanity, because of Adam's fall, inherited a sinful nature,

which makes all human beings vulnerable to sin (Romans 3:23). Sin is exceedingly offensive to God (Romans 6:23) and humanity is utterly incapable to remedy this fallen state (Eph. 2:1-5, 12). Man is a sinner and man cannot save himself.

SALVATION

We in URCCM believe that salvation is a gift of God's grace through faith based solidly in the finished work of Jesus Christ on the cross (Ephesians 2:8-9). Christ's death accomplished full justification through faith and redemption from sin. Christ died in our place (Romans 5:8-9) and bore our sins in His own body (1 Peter 2:24).

Salvation is received by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone.

THE CHURCH

We strongly believe that the Church, the Body of Christ, is a spiritual organism comprising of all believers of this present age (1 Corinthians 12:12-14; 2 Corinthians 11:2; Ephesians 1:22-23, 5:25-27). We believe in the ordinances of believer's <u>water</u> baptism by immersion as a testimony to Christ and identification with Him, and the Lord's Supper as a remembrance of Christ's death and shed blood (Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 2:41-42, 18:8; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26). Through the local church, believers are to be taught to obey the Lord and to testify concerning their faith in Christ as Savior and to honor Him by holy living. We believe in the Great Commission as the primary mission of the Church. The gospel of the grace of God is to be preached to all the world (Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 1:8; 2 Corinthians 5:19-20).

ETERNAL HOPE

We believe in the blessed hope (Titus 2:13), the personal and imminent coming of the Lord Jesus Christ to rapture His saints (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18). We believe in the visible and bodily return of Christ to the earth with His saints to establish His promised millennial kingdom (Zechariah 14:4-11; 1 Thessalonians 1:10; Revelation 3:10, 19:11-16, 20:1-6). We believe in the physical resurrection of all men—the saints to everlasting joy and bliss on the New Earth, and the wicked to eternal punishment in the lake of fire (Matthew 25:46; John 5:28-29; Revelation 20:5-6, 12-13).

TRAINING AND POLICY

URCCM is a citadel of Bible Scholars with decades of spiritual and theological knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- b. Write up of 50 pages (minimum) of personal best book in the Bible.
